(a8b1c4)(John D's 4th child) HENRY NICHOLSON 1853 - 1934 HENRY in 1881 married Isabella Christina (Tina) McKenzie (1859-1921) in the Central Methodist church Durban.

Tina was the youngest daughter of William Mc Kenzie, the first schoolmaster in Richmond. Henry and Tina lived on their property, adjoining the north eastern corner of Richmond village, until her death. In addition to this property they owned Enkobeni Farm and part of Cleveland Farm in Richmond, Good Hope Farm in the Boston district and two farms in the Underberg district - namely X.L. and Fondeling. Henry was a transport rider and for this he had many wagons and a general dealers licence. He transported goods regularly to the eastern Cape and also to Johannesburg and Kimberly until railways connected these towns with Natal. As a progressive he represented Ixopo in the Legislative Assembly of the Natal Parliament from 1891 - 1902. He favoured the formation of a Federation of South African Colonies and not a Union as proposed by the Conservatives. Henry was a foundation member of the Richmond Agricultural Society. He was keenly interested in all forms of sport and was a member of th 1870 Nicholson's cricket team. In 1878 he was president of the Richmond Rifle Association and in 1893 he became foundation member of the first golf club. After the death of his wife, Henry left Richmond and lived with his children. He died in Durban in 1934.

Attended Maritzburg College on condition that he stopped playing the piano. After school he worked in the magistrates court until his mother Tina needed his help in the recruiting agency which she had started for labour for the mines. After his marriage to May Cookburn they lived in Rose Cottage Richmond for two years and then moved to X L Farm Underberg in 1913. He worked the farm for his father from 1913 - 1918 after which it was purchased by Clarice Ellen Nicholson (nee Hackland) wife of J B Nicholson (a8b1c3d1)

A tennis court was on the same site as the existing one today (1985). For many years the site was used as a vegetable garden until John Duggleby Edwin Nicholson put in a hard top all weather court. For a short while Ninian lived in Bulwer. He was a stock inspector and also held the position of Anglican Church warden. In 1929 he worked for Municipal Bantu Affairs in Pmb and lived there until his death. His hobby was breeding and training homer pigeons, He and May had eight children.
